

Quick Tips for REDUCING FINGERPRINT REJECTS



Notations and Stamps

Notes electronically placed on the fingerprints to denote image anomalies:

Amputation (XX) First joint is physically not present. Unable To Print (UP) Fingers are bandaged, crippled, deformed, etc. Scar Stamp (SR) Scarring so severe the pattern type is unknown.



MOST COMMON REJECT REASONS

- 1. Low Quality Images
- 2. Duplicated Finger Images
- 3. Smudges/Shadowing Around Fingerprint Images
- 4. Multiple Images Per Block

- 5. Same Hand Printed Twice
- 6. Fingers Missing from Plains Without Notation
- 7. Fingers Printed in Incorrect Boxes
- 8. Fingers Missing from Rolled and Plains Without Notation
